- Willing to work 500 sweat equity hours
- Yearly gross income between 25-50% of Putnam Co median income

The following items should be brought with you to the fair.

- Proof of residence in Putnam County (Minimum of 1 year)
- Driver's License or a Photo ID
- \$10 cash for credit report
- Social Security Cards & Birth Certificates for everyone in household.
- Copy of lease or rent receipt
- Proof of ALL income sources (pay stubs, social security, etc.)
- Copy of divorce decree, marital dissolution, child support (if applicable)
- List of bank accounts, credit cards, medical & dental bills, utility bills, savings plans, pension plans, court costs, child support, alimony, finance company, auto payments, insurance information (with account numbers on all)
